Softball Park Rules

The Ball Fields at Putnam City Optimist ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITS the following on the ball park premises which includes all parking areas.

- Firearms or Weapons
- Alcohol including 3.2 Beer
- Tobacco, including cigarettes, cigars, pipes and chewing tobacco
- No smoking of any kind will be allowed inside the complex
- Illegal narcotics and drugs of any kind
- Pets of any kind, exception for handicap necessity
- Glass containers
- Bikes, skateboards, scooters, skates and roller blades
- Warming up (playing catch, throwing or hitting) except in the designated areas
- Inappropriate language, actions, comments, sportsmanship, or gestures of any kind
- Team chanting or cheers deemed inappropriate or unsportsmanlike
- Violent behavior be it verbal or physical
- Littering in the dugout, park and parking lot.
- Participants and patrons must be properly dressed.
- Everyone should show proper respect to umpires, players, spectators, and league officials
- No Jewelry of any kind shall be worn by any players
- Handicap and Reserved parking must be respected: vehicles parked illegally will be towed at owner's expense
- Children must be under adult supervision at all times
- No hitting, throwing or pitching into any park fence.
- Lock your cars, PCO is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- PCO is not responsible for damage that occurred by a hit or thrown objects
- No Seeds (Sun Flower, Peanut & others) will be allowed in the Ball Park.

ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS OR CONSTITUTING A PUBLIC NUISANCE WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE BALL PARK WITH THE POSSIBLE OR REFUSAL FOR FUTURE USE
